- Basement There is a pile of stuff ready to be dumped. Since the Russ Smith Garbage Company picks up our trash and has never billed us Keith Dickison made the motion to get 2 gift cards, one each for Bar Smith, the driver, and the other for Russ and Cindy, the owners, in the amount of \$100.
